HEARING GOD IN MY HOUSE

One of the most fundamental aspects of relationships is the ability to communicate. It is also the most important. In our house, we try to instill in our children the truth that God is not only interested in us speaking to Him, but He is also very interested that we hear His voice. In today's busy schedules, Christian families spend less time with each other and much less speaking to God, and even less, hearing His voice. What? We can hear God's voice? Yes, God is not interested in a one-way communication whereby we tell him a list of requests. He wants us and our families to hear Him. Like a newborn baby's parent, He is interested in making sure we have our needs met, and He leaps with joy when the baby responds when He speaks.

The Bible is very clear about this topic and records many ways of hearing God's voice. We can hear God from His written Word, from the still small voice inside us, from other people, dreams, circumstances, etc. God has promised us that we can all hear His voice, as we are His sheep - **"my sheep hear my voice, and I know them and they follow me"** (John 10:27 KJV).

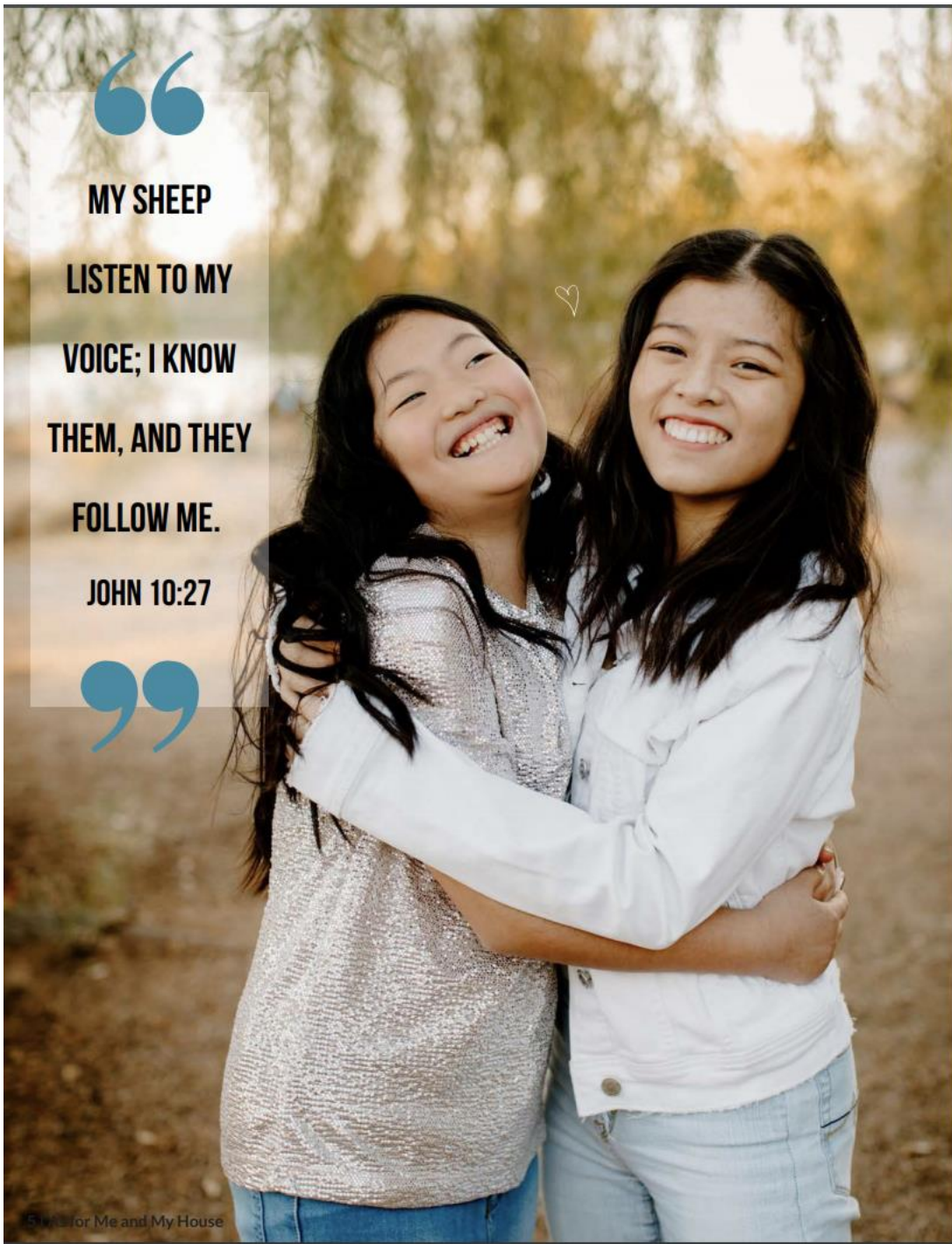

Children can hear very clearly what God is saying. When she was ten years old, my daughter Clarissa joined us in serving in our church's prayer ministry on Tuesday nights. People would come from all over the city for their physical healing. One Tuesday night, a man whom I will call Timothy, came for prayer for his eyes. We - my husband and I and our ten-year-old - were assigned to pray for him but before ministry time, we would usually ask God to show us what He wants for the person. My daughter started writing on her

notepad: sunglasses, stethoscope, glasses. When Timothy came into the room, my husband and I began to pray for him. God had given us words from the Bible, and those words touched him. Then we asked Clarissa. She showed Timothy the drawing of sunglasses, a stethoscope, followed by a pair of glasses. Timothy thanked us and went his way. The following Sunday, Timothy was looking for us and, with a smile on his face, said, "Your daughter is very prophetic! The next day, I went to see my doctor and

found out that I needed new glasses. He said I don't need sunglasses anymore."

At our dinner table, we usually talk about what God is speaking to us and our struggles. We also share night dreams that we have, and each person at the table tries to interpret the dreams. Many times, when our children cannot receive what we have to say, God will give them a dream. Through dreams and dream interpretation, our relationship with our children has been enriched.

God speaks to us through dreams. The Bible tells us "And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, That I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your young men shall see visions, Your old men shall dream dreams." (Acts 2:17 NKJV). As sons and daughters, we can hear from God, interpret dreams, and point people to God. Also, I've found that our night dreams are the vehicle to help us to fulfill our life purpose. They serve as guiding posts to guide us on the right track along with many other ways of hearing God, such as His word, the still small voice, godly counsel, etc.

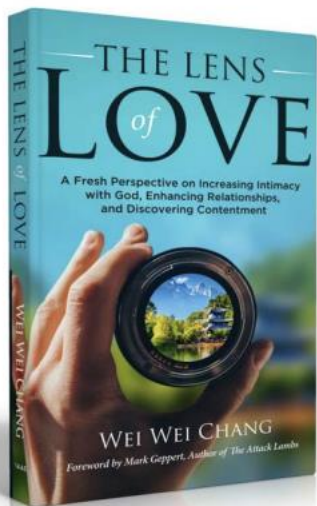
